God says in His Word, "...blessed are my eyes for they see, and my ears for they hear; for many prophets and righteous men desired to see what I see, and did not see it, and to hear what I hear, and did not hear it. (Matthew 13:16)

Therefore I will hide Your Word in my heart that I might not sin against (or miss) the will of God.

Open my eyes, that I may see wondrous things from Your Word today. (Psalm 119:16-18)

Reverence and Intimacy go hand in hand.




The KNOWLEDGE of God


- Since knowledge is power, that power and knowledge can also be used against you.
- Start with the fear (Intimacy) of the Lord, you will be ahead of the game.
- The fear of the Lord is the BEGINNING of knowledge.
- You will be operating in the foreknowledge of God.



The KNOWLEDGE of God

- You will be living in the forethought of God.
- That does not mean you have all the information
- God will tell me what to do and what not to do before enemies can use their knowledge against you.
- You stay ahead of the game.







As a follower of Jesus Christ, you can tap into the Word of God, which gives you the ability to discern what He has ALREADY spoken.

You don't merely tap into knowledge and information that already exist. You are postured to receive the FORETHOUGHT of God; the wisdom behind the written Word.



Some enemy is going to be so far ahead of you in knowledge, skill, and information that you won't stand a chance.

You will have to have the forethought of God to get ahead and stay ahead.

There is only one way to get the beginning of knowledge and that is to have the fear of the Lord. That fear (reverence) comes out of an intimate relationship with God.



The Thermometer

Jesus made a profound statement that was recorded in the Bible. He said,

"If you love Me, keep My commandments." (John 14:15)*



The Thermometer

This was a directive that was given to serve as a thermometer, not as a thermostat.

A thermostat initiates a change in temperature.

A thermometer is used to simply measure the temperature.



The Thermometer

Jesus was saying that you can measure the intensity of your love for him by your willingness to follow His words.

This is the measure of your fear of the Lord.

This is the beginning of knowledge for the rest of your life.

This is what it means to be in love with God.
