#### **Assured and Secured**

1. Live trusting Him in our hearts that <u>He has done everything</u> that needs to be done in order for you to get saved and remain secure in Him:

Ephesians 2: 8-9 --For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Titus 3:5 ---not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,

Hebrews 10:14 ---For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.

### 2. Live to please Christ:

John 8:29 --- And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him."

II Cor. 7:1 --- Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

#### 3. Put Christ and His desires/commands first:

Matthew 6:33--- But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

Colossians 1:16-18 ---16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.

### 4. Read/ Study and obey the Word of God:

Matthew 4:4 ---4 But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.

- II Timothy 3: 14-17 ---But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned them, 15 and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
- 16 All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.
